The United Church-run Edmonton Indian Residential School was no better than any of the hundreds of other such institutions across Canada. In 1961, the children took action against their poor and insufficient diet. ##### Take Action in Support of Palestinian Mission and Service Partner

Six leading, respected Palestinian civil society and human rights organizations have been extraordinarily and suddenly designated as "terrorist organizations" by the Israeli government. [Defence for Children International-Palestine](#), a United Church Mission and Service partner, is one of the six organizations. This means all of their activities are now banned, and it authorizes the Israeli government to close their offices, seize their assets, and arrest and jail their staff members. It also prohibits funding or even publicly expressing support for their activities. Imagine this happening to your Community of Faith, your Regional Council office, or the General Council offices. We are a global church, a small part of the body of Christ, and so many of those names came from around the world - especially the Global South, the majority of the planet's population, where millions cannot get access to vaccines or enough medical care. Reuben Daka's story into the reality of a world where the equity God calls us to is not practiced.

As we remember the dead, may we fight for the living. Mission and Service continues to work with global partners to secure vaccines and [your donations to this urgent work](#) make a difference. The church also continues to call on the Government of Canada to use its influence and global aid budget to make desperately needed vaccines and medical supports available.

As many Canadians begin to see the way out of the COVID-19 pandemic through vaccines, The United Church of Canada is adding a [vigorous advocacy campaign](#) to its [COVID-19 Global Response](#) and continuing to ask people to financially support global partners dealing with the ongoing pandemic. ACT Alliance, a global coalition of churches, notes that Global South nations will reach herd immunity levels only in 2024, if ever. The new chapter of the COVID-19 Global Response appeal asks people to [advocate](#) with the Canadian government for more vaccine sharing; [donate](#) to the ongoing appeal; and show solidarity by [buying a vaccine](#) for someone in the Global South (you can do this as a gift, and even choose when the gift is delivered.
