### **Letter Concerning Ukraine: United Church Ethnocultural Networks**

Members of the United Church Ethnocultural Networks have written an open letter to Communities of Faith, expressing deep concern over manifestations of racism in the midst of the war in Ukraine. News media have reported that Black and south Asian students have been hindered from leaving the country

to find safety elsewhere, primarily because of their skin colour. Concern is also expressed over mainstream media coverage of the war in Ukraine to the neglect of other disturbing events and conflicts, nationally and globally. The letter invites United Church members and Communities of Faith to write to their respective MPs, asking the Canadian government to take steps to stop such expressions of racial discrimination. #### **Attention All Ministry Personnel: Active and Retired**

We are now well into April, and it's after Easter ... You may have noticed that the Annual Declaration is still open. After some consultation about when is the best time to complete the AD, it is active from **January 1 to May 15** this year. We hope that this will offer a more convenient time to complete this. You do not need to get a new police records check done each year. A new police records check is only required if you are declaring new criminal charges, or if your police records check is older than 2011.
