Gary Paterson Highlights

- One of the United Church's facilitators for the first study of Human Sexuality in 1980
- A Commissioner at General Council in 1988 when it was decided that "all persons, regardless of sexual orientation, who profess their faith in Jesus Christ are welcome to become members of The United Church of Canada" and that "all members of the United Church are eligible to be considered for ordered ministry".
- Elected Moderator in 2012, the first openly gay person in the world to be chosen as the leader of a major denomination
- Served as an openly gay minister for 30 years
- Married to the first openly gay person ordained in the United Church
- Good speaker with a sense of humour
- Happy to answer questions and engage in conversations
