★ Red Dress Day: Friday May 5

This Friday, May 5, is National Day of Awareness for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls and Two-Spirit people (MMIWG2S). Red dresses are hung in public spaces and people wear red shirts or dresses to honour those who have gone missing or been murdered. Please join this movement to say that you value Indigenous Women, Girls and Two-Spirit people, and to seek justice.

★ <u>Participate in the Moose Hide Campaign to Combat Violence and Call for</u> <u>Justice, Sunday May 7, and May 11</u>

Canada is in the midst of an ongoing national crisis of violence against Indigenous women, girls, and 2S-LGBTQIA+ people. Canada has a long legacy of devaluing Indigenous peoples—in particular Indigenous women, girls, and 2S-LGBTQIA+ people. As a result, many people believe that they do not matter, and that it is acceptable to commit acts of violence upon them. We've seen this reality at work in communities throughout our Regional Council, as the numbered of missing and murdered Indigenous people continues to grow. The United Church invites your participation. Think about prayers or other ways of sharing this Indigenous-led campaign in worship. Votes for the remit process now underway!

Votes for the remit process are now underway. **Approval of this remit will enable the creation of an autonomous National Indigenous Organization within The United Church of Canada.** The remit requires a vote by every regional council and each pastoral charge's governing body. Abstentions are considered a vote against the remit. Some people have been asking questions about this remit process. One, the deadline date is **March 31, 2024**. That deadline is next year, and it gives more than one full year to vote. Two, the vote is for the governing board of a community of faith (such as a church council). It does not need to be a vote for the full congregation. The process for Remits is outlined in *The Manual* of The United Church of Canada in section F.2.
