♥ It is with sadness that we share the announcement of the death of Fern Klassen on July 10th 2023 after a short battle with dementia. Fern was born October 30th, 1934 in Tawatinaw, north east of Westlock. Fern was a long time member of the United Church and an early CGIT member. When asked by her first son what CGIT referred to she replied "Crazy Girls in Town!" The response said much about Fern's humour. Fern loved to sing and participated in the choir at Westlock United and the local choir group The Versatiles. Fern fully participated in the wider life of the church as a Presbytery Rep. She loved the community of Presbytery. Fern was also one of the first cohorts of LLWLs in the Region to complete the course at St. Stephen's. Many congregations in what was once Yellowhead Presbytery experienced Fern's worship leadership for many years. A celebration of life was held for Fern at the Westlock Legion July 22 at 2pm.

★ The United Church Calls on Manitoba to Search the Landfill

Morgan Harris and Marcedes Myran were murdered in 2022 and left in a Winnipeg landfill. Their families and communities are calling for a search of the landfill, but the province of Manitoba refuses. In life, and now in death, Morgan, Marcedes, and thousands of other missing and murdered Indigenous women, girls, and Two Spirit people have been denied the dignity and respect that they deserve. We call on the government to bring Morgan and Marcedes home to their loved ones. We are in solidarity with Camp Morgan and Camp Marcedes in Winnipeg. National Indigenous Spiritual Gathering

The Indigenous church gathers on Treaty 6 Territory in Edmonton, AB, on July 28 - 30, for the 2023 National Indigenous Spiritual Gathering. The theme is "With Strong Voices." Moderator Carmen Lansdowne will give a keynote address on Friday, July 28. Other program elements include installation of new members of the National Indigenous Elders Council and the new National Indigenous Council; panel and plenary discussions, and workshop opportunities. The National Indigenous Spiritual Gathering will bring together 35 young Indigenous people to build community through hand drum songs, arts and crafts, swimming, and activities.
