We hold our neighbours in the Northwest Territories in our prayers and hearts, as many communities are currently being evacuated and some have been destroyed in their current state of emergency.

- ★ Southminster-Steinhauer United Church is thrilled to join St. Stephen's College in announcing Nancy Steeves as the 2023 recipient of St. Stephen's College Honorary Doctor of Ministry, awarded at this year's St. Stephen's College Convocation: October 23, 2023. All are invited. The Doctor of Divinity (honoris causa) is awarded to individuals whose contributions reflect meritorious service, outstanding leadership in denominational or ecumenical contexts, and/or outstanding commitment and contribution to ministry, whether ordered or lay. This degree is awarded for excellence and/or outstanding contributions in one or more of the following areas: Pastoral or missionary experience, Theological scholarship, Faith and public life, Community responsibility.
- ★ Service of Celebration: Hughenden United Church: September 3, 10 a.m. Hughenden United Church is making some changes. Just over a year ago we opened a Thrift Shop in the trailer beside the church that had previously been used as Sunday School space.
