We are in the process of hiring Grace Hussey, January-May 2023. She is a ministry student at the Atlantic School of Theology, a social worker, and a facilitator. She will be working with the Being Good Relations Network on the following priorities, some of which cover some of Julie's work while she is on sabbatical:

- Designing, promoting and facilitating a Lent public book discussion focused on right relations,
- managing and facilitating a May or June movie showing and discussion with a filmmaker,
- calling and hosting a late April Northern Spirit meeting to help communities
 plan their commitments and engagement for June 21 National Indigenous
 People's Day,
- promoting the Being Good Relations Network,
- promoting and collating a survey and replies focused on seeking future direction for the network,
- Northern Spirit cluster development related to right relations, including some consultation and thinking on boundaries.

The money for this comes primarily from the Being Good Relations Network, with a wage subsidy of \$15 an hour related to federal support for people with disabilities. Cecile Fausak chairs Grace's support committee and will be her primary source of accountability. Shannon is the overall supervisor.
