It can be a challenge to find and appoint these people. This particular pastoral charge has had a vacancy for a year now and they have been working with a liaison. However, some of the liaisons aren't as confident in the process as others are. This Pastoral Charge has felt like they haven't received the support they needed. They are waiting for a Supervisor to be appointed. How can we recruit and train the liaisons and recruit more supervisors. The Pastoral relations commission is meeting tomorrow morning and this will be on the agenda.
