★ <u>Licensed Lay Worship Leader Training & Connection Opportunity: Learning on the Way:</u> "Creation, Remembrance and Power: Resources for leading worship", September - November 2023, *Online

An opportunity from the Canadian Shield Regional Council: "A couple of years ago, we had a number of requests from some of the 'graduating students' for opportunities for them to continue to learn and connect with other lay worship leaders. ★ Notes for Lay Worship Leaders & Treasurers, from the Lay Support Committee:

- Licenses are now being renewed for **2 year terms**, good until June 30, 2025.
- Fees remain at \$150 minimum per service, with additional \$75 if doing a 2-part charge on the same Sunday.

- Mileage rates are 55 cents per Km. (same as Regional Council rates).
- If you are paid more than \$500 at a church they are to make a T4A for you at end of year.
- If you make under \$500 from a church, you will not receive a T4A but you still must claim all income made to the government.

<u>An invitation to active Ministry Personnel from The Right Reverend Dr.</u> Carmen Landsdowne....

If you've been following me on social media or read E-ssentials digital newsletter, you'll know that part of my Flourishing project was a **pilot leadership school**: **(Re)Generate: Invigorating Leadership**. I'm happy to say that the nomination/application form is now available on the UCC website. The program is for ministry personnel, is 3 weeks per year in 2024 & 2025, with a cost of up to \$1,500/year, for a total of \$3,000 over two years (all-inclusive, covering travel, accommodation, and meals for in-person gatherings). To enhance the diversity of participants (including part-time ministers), and to fulfill our commitments to equity, some participants could contribute less, or apply for funds towards child care, or other expenses that would help facilitate their participation. **Deadline for all applications** is **September 30th**. <u>Information Session: The New Horizons for Seniors Program Grant 2023-2024,</u> Thursday, September 7, 6:30 p.m. EST, *online*

The New Horizons for Seniors Program Grant for 2023 – 2024 application process is now open. Grant applications are due on **Thursday, September 14, 2023, at 3 pm (EST).** This federal grant provides up to \$25,000 to support communities of faith to provide programming that offers meaningful engagement for seniors. Eligible projects must be led by seniors and be volunteer based. We will be holding an **information session** for communities of faith interested in applying for this grant on Thursday, September 7, at 6:30 p.m. EST (4:30 p.m. MT). If you plan to apply for the grant this year, you will need to have a well-developed project idea and at a minimum have familiarized yourself with the grant application process before attending the session since the timeline to apply is so short. Alternatively, if you intend to apply in a future year, you are welcome to attend to hear ideas from other communities of faith and to learn about the process.
