Orange Shirt Day/ the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is an important public space for truth telling, and for commitments to challenging ongoing colonization. As part of our church's <u>living into the Apologies</u>, let's join with others to help ensure the ongoing history and impacts of the residential schools system are never forgotten- and that together, we bring about real change. Please make plans for Sunday worship on September 24; Sunday October 1 is also an important space for naming the ongoing violence facing Indigenous women, girls, and Two Spirit people in preparation for

★ New Affirming resources and United Church statement on the "Million Person Marches"

On Wednesday, September 20th, anti-2SLGBTQIA+ activists plan to rally at legislatures, city halls, and school board offices across the country under the "1 Million March 4 Children" banner. While they claim to be in support of "parental rights," this is explicitly an anti-2SLGBTQIA+ rally. They're supported by a big tent of far-right groups, including Christian Nationalists, white supremacists, and anti-public education activists. By the time you read this, most of these marches will be over. But they'll be back.

As an Affirming Regional Council, we encourage your ministry to be aware of the fear and hate that exist in so many of our communities- and the possibilities for a public, intentional and explicit expression of God's love. Christians need to step up and proclaim that love in word and deed. Here is a summary of ideas, and some graphics for you to use, shaped in part of over 60 congregational Affirming leaders from the Prairies and north who gathered last week to plan. And here is a statement from the national church.

★ Faithful Footprints energy efficiency opportunity for Northern Spirit

<u>Faithful Footprints</u> is a national church program that helps congregations lower their energy use through careful retrofits. They asked the Region to tell you that they have some free energy audits available to congregations within a three -our drive of Edmonton (and they apologise to those outside that radius- but are very happy to work with you on other options). And they have other options on tap for everyone. Please <u>contact Jessica Ryan</u> if you'd like to look at reducing your carbon footprint as part of the United Church's wider climate commitments.

If you've been following me on social media or read E-ssentials digital newsletter, you'll know that part of my Flourishing project was a **pilot leadership school:**

(Re)Generate: Invigorating Leadership. I'm happy to say that the nomination/application form is now available on the UCC website. The program is for ministry personnel, is 3 weeks per year in 2024 & 2025, with a cost of up to \$1,500/year, for a total of \$3,000 over two years (all-inclusive, covering travel, accommodation, and meals for in-person gatherings). To enhance the diversity of participants (including part-time ministers), and to fulfill our commitments to equity, some participants could contribute less, or apply for funds towards child care, or other expenses that would help facilitate their participation. Notes for Lay Worship Leaders & Treasurers, from the Lay Support Committee:

- Licenses are now being renewed for **2 year terms**, good until June 30, 2025.
- Fees remain at \$150 minimum per service, with additional \$75 if doing a 2-part charge on the same Sunday.
- Mileage rates are 55 cents per Km. (same as Regional Council rates).
- If you are paid more than \$500 at a church they are to make a T4A for you at end of year.
- If you make under \$500 from a church, you will not receive a T4A but you still must claim all income made to the government.
