# **★** Updates on Remit voting: set a date; accessing your M&S or Community of Faith ID; invitation to a learning circle

Two letters were sent recently to all pastoral charges in the Regional Council: <u>Click here</u> for the letter from <u>General Secretary Rev Michael Blair</u>, and <u>click here for the letter from your Regional Council leadership</u>. Both have important reminders and resources on the Remit on creating an autonomous Indigenous organization within the United Church. You are urged to set a date for a vote if you have not done so already. Do not hesitate to call the Regional office with any questions, so that we can put you in touch with resource people. Beginning in late January, the Regional Council will be calling pastoral charges who have not voted.

In order to vote, you will need your Mission and Service number or your Community of Faith ID. Your Mission and Service number can be found in your ChurchHub account or in your PAR info, if you use PAR. When you sign into your ChurchHub.ca, your Community of Faith ID number should be in the upper right-hand corner of your screen. If either of these aren't set up for you or just don't work, don't hesitate to call

the office and we'll help.
