

★ Remit voting deadline approaching! Have you submitted your vote?

The remit vote deadline date is **March 31, 2024.** Do not hesitate to call the Regional office with any questions, so that we can put you in touch with resource people. In order to vote, you will need your Mission and Service number or your Community of Faith ID. Your Mission and Service number can be found in your ChurchHub account or in your PAR info, if you use PAR. When you sign into your ChurchHub.ca, your Community of Faith ID number should be in the upper right-hand corner of your screen. If either of these aren't set up for you or just don't work, don't hesitate to call the office and we'll help.

If you have voted on the Remit, have you actually sent your vote in? Please be sure that you email or mail your response in ASAP -- we are waiting for 46% of our churches to send in their vote. Let's be united in taking seriously our responsibility to care for each other.

★ Invitation: Worldwide Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage, in Lent and beyond

In this season of Lent, pilgrims in 125 countries are mapping the 41 km length of the Gaza Strip, by walking in prayerful solidarity with the people of Gaza and calling for a ceasefire. These pilgrimages are not demonstrations; they are times of deep lament, contemplation, and community solidarity with the many, many people and the lands and waters who have been so deeply harmed by the immense violence in Palestine and Israel. They can take place in communities of any size, in any configuration, with any partners. ★ Resource: Regional Council response to Alberta's planned legislation targeting transgender people

The chairperson of the Regional Council, Rev Helen Reed, has responded to Alberta
Premier Danielle Smith's announcement regarding the planned restrictions of the rights of transgender, non-binary, Two Spirit, and other gender diverse children and youth. A further resource on advocacy and facts is being prepared; one resource already available comes to us from Calgary's Affirming Connections, and is a careful compilation
of links to analysis and statements of concern that is being continuously updated.

ATTENTION: Pastoral Charges with Manses

We have been notified by Erik Mathiesen, Chief Financial Officer of the United Church of Canada about a requirement for all Pastoral Charges with manses to submit a CRA form related to "Underused Housing Tax". Click here to read the full memo. Treasurer webinars held monthly on Churchx will include a bit of a "how to" complete the form. It is the responsibility of the United Church General Council and Regional Councils to flag the risk related to not complying with the requirement. There is an apparent duty to file - with a penalty for noncompliance.

Action: Major concerns about Canada's military sales to Israel

United Church people are asked to keep <u>writing our members of Parliament using this action tool</u> or our own letters, as concern grows that Canada's military exports to Israel may risk complicity in genocide. In their December 2023 report, "<u>Fanning the Flames: The grave risk of Canada's arms exports to Israel</u>," Project Ploughshares reveals that Canadian corporations, with permits granted by the Canadian government, regularly export military hardware and components to Israel. (Project Ploughshares is the ecumenical peace research body related to the Canadian Council of Churches, of which The United Church of Canada is a member.) In fact, when adjusted for inflation, Canadian sales in 2023 were almost as high as the peak year, 1987. Only by ending its military exports to Israel can Canada meet its domestic and international obligations to eliminate violations of international humanitarian law in Gaza, including possible war crimes.

Lenten liturgy for Palestine and Israel

In recent years, some congregations have started a new tradition; extinguishing candles on Sundays through Lent. This dimming of light during the season of Lent reminds people that this 40-day journey is leading to the cross of Good Friday. The Worship Group for the United Network for Justice and Peace in Palestine and Israel (UNJPPI) sees a connection between the journey to Good Friday and the journey of the Palestinian people. At the same time, we recognize and need to acknowledge that, in the West, we have been complicit in the ongoing discrimination towards Palestinians and the destruction of their culture, their land and their people.
