This one-day in-person workshop will help ordained ministry personnel explore the adaptive challenges that are facing the church, and equip them with new leadership skills to address these challenges. **All in-service ordained ministry personnel in Edmonton and area are invited to participate.** There is no cost to attend, and lunch will be provided!

The workshop is offered as part of a doctoral research study taking place across Canada in 2024 and 2025 led by Rev. Clara King (ClaraKing.com), which is testing a new way to teach adaptive leadership to clergy. ★ Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage, with national church leaders

Many communities of faith across Canada, and around the world, with their bodies prayerfully mapped Gaza onto their own communities through the worldwide Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage this Lent. This renewed invitation is for everyone! Walk or roll together in your own community, preferably before May 13. Pray and act for a ceasefire, and for more than a ceasefire- for a just peace for all in Palestine and Israel. KAIROS member church leaders, including Moderator Carmen Lansdowne, will gather in Ottawa on May 22-23 to bring these calls in person to the Government of Canada and

Parliamentarians. They'll urge them to take immediate and sustained steps to advance and promote the calls made in the <u>Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage</u>. How do our buildings; grounds; and ministry with children, youth, and people beyond our doors reflect our relationship to this racist society?
