With great sadness, The United Church of Canada announces the death of The Very Rev., The Honourable Dr. Lois M. Wilson, the denomination's 28th Moderator, and the first woman to fill the role. She faithfully served as Moderator from 1980 to 1982. The Rev. Wilson died in hospital in Fredericton, NB, on Sept. 13, 2024. She was 97 years old. A memorial service is planned for October 15, at 11:00 a.m. at Metropolitan UC, 56 Queen St E, Toronto, ON. The service will be livestreamed on YouTube. Read the full news story on the UC website.

\* Regional network statement on the police killing of an Indigenous child

The Being Good Relations Network of the United Church in Alberta, Yellowknife, and Northeast BC expresses its heartfelt sorrow to the family and community of 15-year-old Hoss Lightning of Samson Cree Nation. Hoss was shot dead by the RCMP in Wetaskiwin AB after he called 911. We name that Hoss was seeking help, and that yet again, a call from a person in need resulted in a shooting death instead. We name that police shootings disproportionately target Indigenous people across Canada, and that this has been happening for many years, and continues. Between August 29 and September 8 2024, across Canada, six Indigenous people died at the hands of police. Being Good Relations invites you to read and share the statement.

Mennonite Church Canada's Palestine-Israel Network (PIN) encourages congregations to mark the October 7 anniversary of the mass murder and kidnappings in Israel, and the start of the genocide in Gaza. The PIN has prepared an online package of resources designed for congregational prayer or small group use. #### Olive harvest focus and resources for Palestine, October 2024

People in Living Skies Regional Council, with support from some great Manitoba expertise, invite United Church people into this opportunity to understand the violence facing Palestinian farmers and villagers as they commence their annual olive harvest. In Gaza, part of the Occupied Palestinian Territories, harvest will not happen at all this year, amidst the unspeakable devastation and starvation. Together, we will explore why, and what Canadians can do. This focus is intended for everyone, and we hope people who live in rural or remote areas closer to the rhythms of harvesting, fishing, and hunting will bring their lived experience to this work. **The planners warmly welcome participation from across Turtle Island** to film viewing, learning, worship, personal reflection, and advocacy. Key dates to help us prepare in advance include the Season of Creation, and the World Council of Churches' Week for Peace in Palestine and Israel. In October we'll offer resources for World Communion Sunday and World Food Day. Information will be shared throughout on this web page.
