### Regional network statement on the police killing of an Indigenous child

The Being Good Relations Network of the United Church in Alberta, Yellowknife, and Northeast BC expresses its heartfelt sorrow to the family and community of 15-year-old Hoss Lightning of Samson Cree Nation. Hoss was shot dead by the RCMP in Wetaskiwin AB after he called 911. We name that Hoss was seeking help, and that yet again, a call from a person in need resulted in a shooting death instead. We name <u>that police</u> <u>shootings disproportionately target Indigenous people across Canada</u>, and that this has been happening for many years, and continues. Between August 29 and September 8 2024, across Canada, <u>six Indigenous people died at the hands of police</u>. Being Good Relations invites you to <u>read and share the statement</u>.
