★ Update on United Church policy on Palestine and Israel

On October 19, the online meeting of General Council 44 adopted new policies related to Palestine and Israel. In summary, the United Church is: (1) adopting the strategies of Boycott, Divestment and Sanction (BDS) movement; and (2) responding positively to the request of NEW04 - Join the Apartheid Free Communities Movement; and (3) joining the consensus of the international human rights community in recognizing and rejecting Israel's apartheid system of laws and legal procedures towards the Palestinian people. These policies are an invitation to the entire church, not just the General Council, so we are all encouraged to be informed of the details.

Regional network statement on the police killing of an Indigenous child

The Being Good Relations Network of the United Church in Alberta, Yellowknife, and Northeast BC expresses its heartfelt sorrow to the family and community of 15-year-old Hoss Lightning of Samson Cree Nation. Hoss was shot dead by the RCMP in Wetaskiwin AB after he called 911. We name that Hoss was seeking help, and that yet again, a call from a person in need resulted in a shooting death instead. We name that police shootings disproportionately target Indigenous people across Canada, and that this has been happening for many years, and continues. Between August 29 and September 8 2024, across Canada, six Indigenous people died at the hands of police. Being Good
