Our Regional Council's newest Two Spirit and LGBTQIA+ affirming ministry is <a href="Athabasca United Church"><u>Athabasca United Church</u></a> which will hold the final step in its formal process on November 24 at a public service of celebration. Everyone is invited to join the celebration as you wish and can. The sermon will be offered by Chaplain Rev. Beatrice Gale, who has been a United Church minister for 16 years, serving Memorial United Church in Prince Edward Island and then Brookfield Pastoral Charge in Nova Scotia before joining the Canadian Army in
