On August 23, 2025, about seventy people from at least ten different United Churches rolled and walked through downtown Edmonton in the city's first Pride Parade in seven years.

Short reminders of our history for this Centennial year

The church has a long and varied history, providing both education and medical care across the country as communities developed. While the early workers are gone, many kept records and some of those records have survived to tell us of people and of the work they did under difficult conditions. In the early 1950s, the United Church established a central archive in Toronto at Victoria University though it has recently moved. Others were established across the country and today an archives network includes eight regional archives to protect our stories. As stated in 1924 by Canada's Dominion Archivist Arthur G. Doughty, "Of all national assets, archives are the most precious. They are the gift of one generation to another."

This training is held in two sessions, online over Zoom, one evening per week: Wednesdays September 17 and 24, 6:30 - 8:30. ★ Regional pastoral letter regarding controversial Christian concert in Saskatoon & Edmonton

Throughout the summer, people across the country have been dealing with a <u>string of concerts planned by an American extreme right-wing pastor</u>, all of which were deliberately booked at publicly-owned venues, rather than churches. Saskatoon and Edmonton are currently the only two cities in Canada to have not cancelled Pastor

Feucht's permit. Please read and share this letter from Mickey Wilson and Rev Leigh Sinclair, the convenors of the Affirming Committee and the Regional Council. People across the province are still contacting the Alberta government, urging cancellation and respect for the human rights of the communities Feucht targets. If you or your congregation shares these concerns, please make them known, in order to offer a different Christian perspective.

This is an invitation to those in the southern and eastern parts of our Regional Council, and those who happen to be in the area. Please join KAIROS Prairies North for a day that will include a tour of the former Blue Quills Indian Residential School building led by survivors/Elders, lunch, and learning about Treaty. All welcome! This **in-person only** event is within a reasonable drive of the Edmonton area to the west and the Battlefords area to the east.

This gathering is hosted by the KAIROS Prairies North Decolonization Group with gratitude to our community partners, in particular University nuhelot'įne thaiyots'į nistameyimâkanak Blue Quills and the United Church of Canada's Reconciliation and Justice Fund. This gathering is free of charge, including lunch. We do ask you to register so we know numbers and can send you material.
