Short reminders of our history for this Centennial year

Throughout 2025, we'll be featuring very short stories about United Church history. For nearly 125 years, the United Church and its predecessor denominations have offered health care in remote areas of Canada's west coast. Hospitals in Bella Bella and Bella Coola B.C. have operated with support from the Mission and Service fund. Health care professionals have often been recruited through the United Church. Services have included emergency care and obstetrical services as well as physiotherapy, pharmacy and public and mental health education. The most serious cases could be transferred by air to Vancouver or Victoria, accompanied by a medical professional. These hospitals most recently have worked in conjunction with the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (VCHA) and United Church involvement in these hospitals is currently coming to an end.

Northern Spirit has purchased a license for an **Advent Small Group Study with Four Worship Services**, as a gift for all of our congregations and churches to access for free this Advent season.

We never tire of the story. Each Advent, we set out the beloved figures of the creche and are invited again into the mystery of incarnation. In this small group study and worship series, we look more closely at the figures and what they reveal about the human journey of faith, the bigger picture of Love, and the Divine Longing at the heart of Christmas.

Alongside four study sessions, you'll also receive complete Advent worship services—rich with liturgy, Advent candle-lighting, all-ages activities, Scripture, reflections, prayers, and music suggestions. Together, they invite us to approach the creche with

fresh wonder, to notice who is present (and who is missing), and to be shaped by Love that is already here and still arriving.

Personnel document is now available online. You can find it in the Downloads section at the bottom of the <u>Ministers' Salary Schedule and Cost of Living Groups</u> webpage. The increases to salaries of ministry personnel are not automatically made by ADP. General Council Office staff do not update ADP with minimum salary data. Your pastoral charge ADP administrator must update the minister's salary in TeamPay or inform ADP of the new salary amount for the pay period beginning January 1.
